2013-2014 Tuition Assistance Program Now Underway — Tuition assistance application forms are now available in the parish office. Catholic families who belong to the Diocese of Gary parish and have their children enrolled in any diocesan school, grades Kindergarten - 12, may apply. Preschool students are not eligible. A \$25.00 nonrefundable processing fee must accompany the application.

The filing deadline is Monday, February 18, 2013. This is the date that completed applications must be returned to the pastor. This deadline will be strictly enforced. Parents will be notified of the results in writing by April 30, 2013.
